We believe it is important to acknowledge the full scope of the work residents and fellows do by continuing this competition.

We have made some changes to the competition in light of the new online format. Highlighted below are several important points:

1. Residents and Fellows will be informed of acceptance of projects for presentation at the end of April.
2. **We have eliminated the poster category** and will conduct a competition for voice-over PowerPoint slide format only.
3. Voice-over PowerPoint presentations will be limited to 6 minutes
4. The voice-over PowerPoint presentations should be **uploaded by May 20, 2020**.

Judging will be completed early June and prizes will be announced on the Summit website. Winners will be contacted to collect their awards.
